The June 1, 2025 increase of \$3.50 was allocated as follows: \$2.20 to the Wage, \$1.00 to the Health & Welfare, \$0.10 to the Defined Benefit Pension, \$0.15 to the Money Purchase Pension and \$0.05 to the HRA.
